NIDA T32 Postdoctoral Traineeship in Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Services Research

- NIDA-funded Postdoctoral Scholar positions in substance use treatment and services research in the UCSF Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences are available on a rolling basis
- Traineeships are two years, with a possible third year
- Scholars work with a mentor to design and implement substance use disorder (SUD) studies
- Scholars select specific focus areas for independent research projects working with core faculty.
- Current scholar research includes substance use disorder treatment and services as related to:
 - Addressing health disparities and advancing health equity
 - Integration of SUD research in health care systems
 - Technology-based SUD intervention research
 - Innovative SUD/HIV treatment, prevention, and services research
 - Emerging areas including innovative therapeutics and delivery models
